AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE PLAN:

The aim of this Plan is to help the parishioners of Upham be able to support themselves when faced with an emergency situation within the village. It should also provide important information to the emergency services regarding the ongoing situation and the requirements of the village. It is highlighted that the risk of the Emergencies related to adverse weather conditions, with the exception of snow, will increase with Global Warming.

Should it be considered that a critical emergency has taken place within the village, the Parish Clerk, Mrs Anne Collins or in her absence Councillor Ross Snowdon or Councillor Dalley must be contacted as soon as possible. It will then be up to this person to get the Emergency Plan under way.

This will happen in the following order:

1. Contact Emergency Services and the Upham Emergency Coordinators
2. Delegate someone to do an assessment of the incident, identify hazards, those involved, and estimate casualties, estimate requirements.
3. Have Emergency Control Centre set up and manned.
4. Contact people who have offered to help.
5. Contact people in the village who have medical or first aid experience if required.
6. Arrange for vulnerable people to be contacted.
7. Contact and Jenni Bell (jenni@sugarweb.co / 01747 860400) and ask them to put messages on village website www.uphamvillage.org.uk and Mike Elliott (01489 860193, 07807 479114) at Commshub@uphamvillage.org.uk letting people know where the emergency is and where to go for emergency shelter.

EMERGENCY ACTION STRATEGY

The following strategy has been devised to meet the Aims and Objectives outlined in the previous section.

The strategy is based on providing when possible advanced warning of a potential emergency and ensuring that should a major emergency occur in the village that those effected, and the various Emergency Action Groups are in place and all those concerned are aware of the emergency facilities and lead emergency workers know their responsibilities.

To implement this strategy several Emergency Groups have been formed:

In addition, Air Quality will be periodically monitored and if extremely poor the Village Residents will be alerted by CommsHub

EMERGENCY CONTROL CENTRE

If seen as necessary, the Parish Clerk or acting Emergency Coordinator shall determine the need for and if required call for the setting up of an Emergency Control Centre

Depending on the epicenter of the Emergency Incident the Emergency Control Centre will be located at either the **Pavilion at the Recreation Ground** or **Upham Village Hall**.

The following Action Plan to be activated:

- Contact relevant Emergency Rest Centre key holder and obtain key.
- Open Emergency Rest Centre and ensure utilities are operational.
- Contact Emergency Coordinator and Lead of Upham Community Group and request attendance at the Emergency Control Centre.
- Contact Emergency Services and inform them that an Emergency Centre has been set up and its location.
- Contact Resident Awareness/Alert Group for required support.
- Check availability of communication devices e.g. mobile telephones, chargers, and Laptops.
- Analyze Emergency Situation from feedback emergency assessors and guidance from the relevant representatives of the Emergency Service(s)
- Determine whether there is a need and if so, hold a Community Emergency Meeting.

REST CENTRE ACTIVATION PLAN

- Contact Rest Centre key holder and obtain key.
- Open Emergency Rest Centre and ensure utilities are operational.
- Contact Emergency Centre to request Resident Awareness/Alert Group support.
- Check availability of first aid resources and if required provisions e.g. food, blankets etc. if not available obtain required provisions.
- Delegate responsibilities to attending members of Resident Awareness/Alert Group.
- Coordinate activities with Emergency Services, first aid and Care Providers.

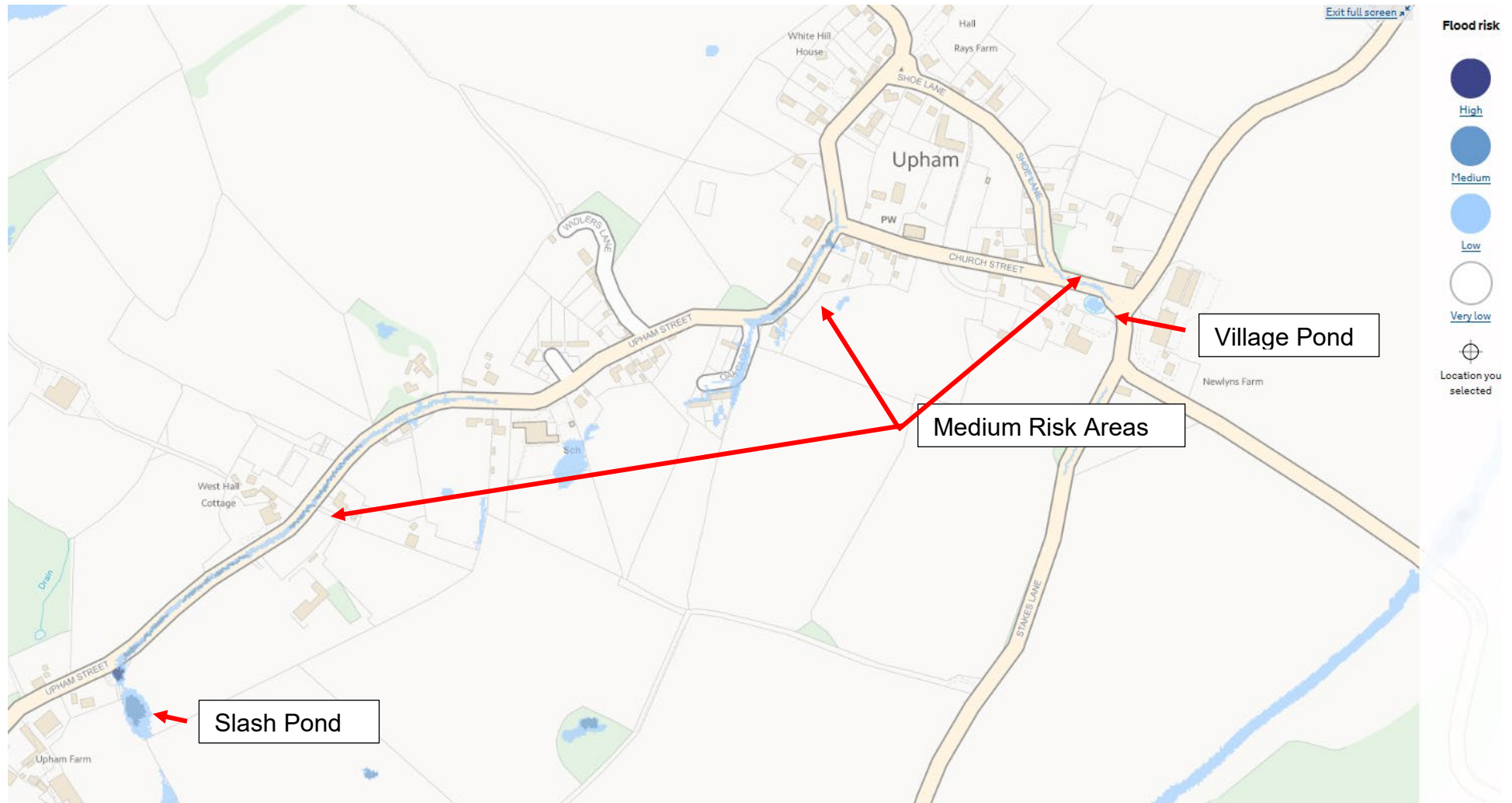

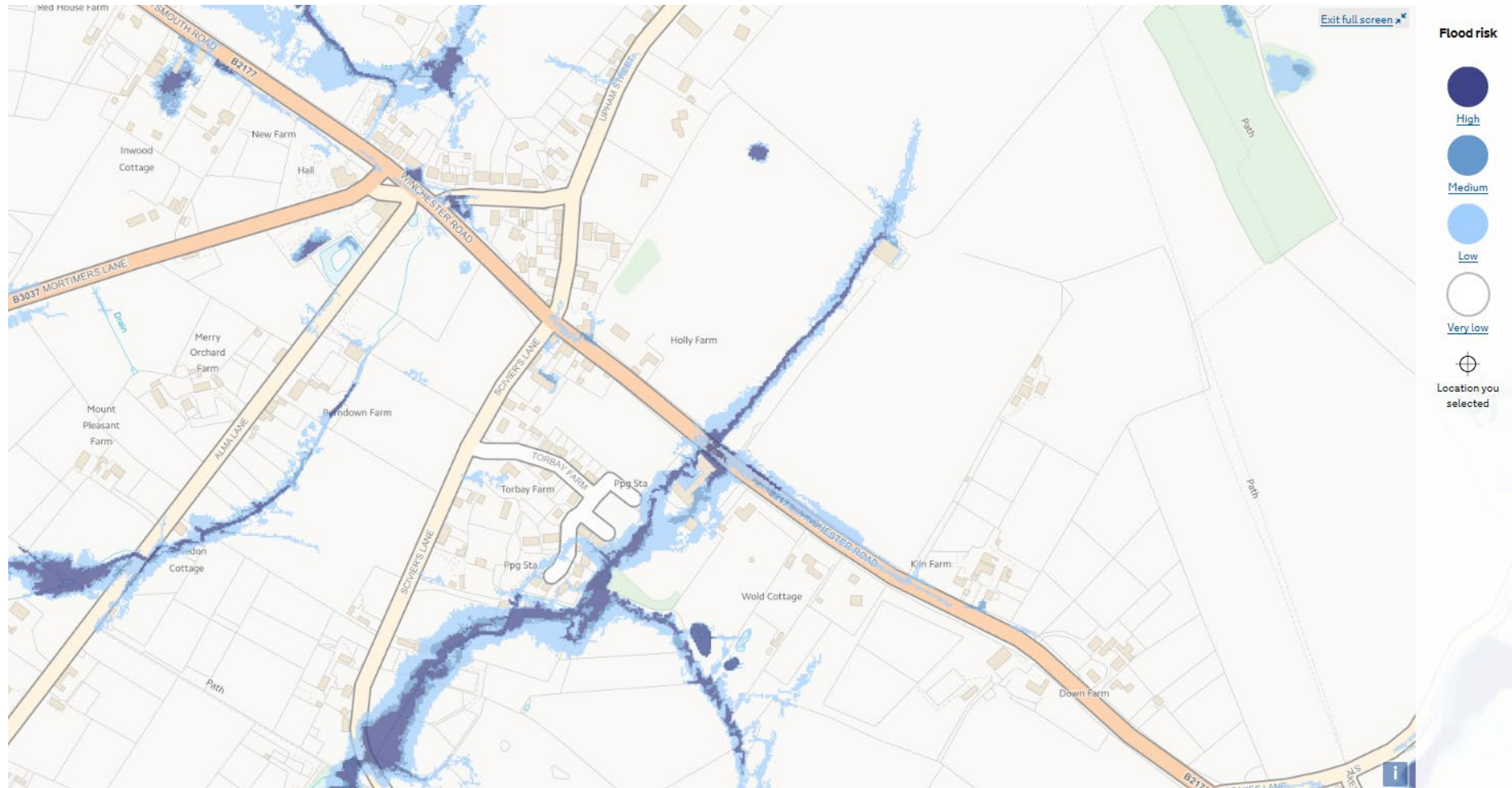
