


Bigpath Farm, Dean and Street End.

Distance: 7.7km 4.8mi

Park at the recreation ground. There are five stiles on the walk, two are not easy to cross, all are passable by dogs.

Cross the football pitch and continue on the green track straight ahead. Follow this, ignoring two paths to the right, until it turns left and joins a track. Turn right on the track.

Continue to a road at Bigpath Farm. Cross the road and continue ahead uphill on the track until reaching a road.

At the road turn left and then after a short distance fork right onto a bridleway. Follow this to a large kissing gate on the left. Go through the gate. This takes you into an open access area where you are free to walk. Take the well-defined path which bears slightly right and then down to a kissing gate. Go through this and then another onto a road, Dean Lane. Turn right.

Continue along the road until reaching a path on the right before the bend.

Follow this well-defined path across fields to a tee junction at the corner of the last field. Turn left on a path and after a short distance take a path to the right up a bank crossing a double stile. Go ahead following the field edge to a stile and cross this to drop down to a road, Beeches Hill.

Cross the road and up a bank crossing a stile. Bear right to follow a path across the field to a stile, then the field edge to another stile and across this to a road, Ashton Lane.

Cross the road and go ahead following the signs around the barns at Street End Farm to a green track. Take this and follow it to the right. Continue to a kissing gate. Continue straight ahead dropping down to another kissing gate and then uphill until the path bears left around a bar gate and onto a road.

Turn left and keeping right return along the road past the pond and turn right into Shoe Lane, past the Brushmakers Arms and on to the recreation ground.
