


Woodcote, Little Belmore Cottage and Observation Post

Distance: 5.8km 3.6mi

Park at the recreation ground. There are two stiles on the walk, both dog friendly.

Cross the football pitch and continue on the green track straight ahead. Follow this, ignoring the first path to the right. Do not take the second path to the right either but note this is the return route. Continue on downhill following the track until it turns left and joins a track. Turn left on the track. Continue to a road, Ower Farm Lane.

Turn right and continue along the road. Where the road bears right go ahead on a track. Pass a field gate on the right and then go through a gap on the right in the hedge to follow a path across fields to a stile. Cross the stile and walk along a green track fenced on both sides. Do not continue ahead and cross the stile to a road but turn left to follow the green track with the hedge and road on the right. At the top of the track cross the stile and go through a few trees onto a track at the road edge. Turn left.

Follow the track until it reaches the road where you left it earlier. Retrace the route and shortly after turning right on the uphill green track to the recreation ground, turn left on the path mentioned earlier with fenced woodland on the left. Continue and follow it along the field edge. At a tee junction, before the path goes through a gap in the hedge, turn right up a path along the field edge.

Follow the path around the field edge, past the Observation Post to a tee junction. Turn left and back to the recreation ground.
